## Standards Information Center First stop for standards-related information

The Standards Information Center serves as a starting point to identify information on standards, regulations, conformity assessment and other requirements.

Avoiding export mistakes can increase your company's export volumes by as much as 1-2%. Companies with export volumes of \$500 million or more can recoup up to \$5-10 million annually through compliance with international standards and regulatory requirements.

NIST's Standards Information Center helps U.S. manufacturers and businesses maximize their exports by providing information about national and international standards and regulatory requirements. These requirements are often a first step in product development. The Standards Information Center helps users navigate a complex US and international standards and regulatory landscape.

The Standards Information Center has issued guides on product compliance requirements in specific industry sectors. The guides include information on Federal and State regulatory frameworks, applicable voluntary standards, mandatory technical regulations, and conformity assessment procedures for each sector.
