About

- Located at Boulder, CO and Gaithersburg, MD



Eligibility

- Must be a US citizen or a US Permanent Resident
- Open to currently enrolled undergraduate students majoring in physics, material science, chemistry, mathematics, computer science, or engineering discipline.
- G.P.A of 3.0 or better is recommended



How to apply

- Student's university must submit student's application materials and a grant proposal by *Grants.gov* nominating one or more students.
- Each student must provide to their university an application coversheet, checklist, transcript, 2 letters of recommendation, and personal statement for inclusion in the university's proposal.

- Housing and travel allotments available
- Receive a stipend of \$5500 for 11 week program
- Demonstrate your potential to be a scientist or engineer!
