This sample ballot is a consolidated ballot containing all offices to be voted upon in Gwinnett County. To determine which district offices appear on your ballot, compare the district on your Election Precinct Card to the districts shown on this sample ballot. NOTE: All Congressional, State Senate and State Representative districts are elected this year. However, only County Commission Chairman, District 1 and 3, and Board of Education Districts 1, 3, and 5 are up for election this year. If a district office is not on this ballot it does not have candidates running in the primary.
