This sample ballot is a consolidated ballot containing all offices to be voted upon in Gwinnett County. NOTE: All Congressional, State Senate and State Representative districts are elected this year. However, only County Commission Chairman, District 1 and 3, and Board of Education Districts 1, 3, and 5 are up for election this year. If a district office is not on this ballot it does not have candidates running in the primary.
