**Subject:** The AI Risk Management should explicitly ban Post-Selections

Dear AI Framework,

I browsed your document, which seems to indicate that the AI Framework Advisory Committee is still unaware of the rampant misconducts in the US associated with Post-Selections in AI.

Post-Selections in AI must be banned because it is impractical at all.

At least, all AI projects that conduct Post-Selections must provide (1) how many networks have been trained and (2) the average errors over all trained networks.
