Large providers like Apple (<https://techcrunch.com/2020/06/25/apple-is-bringing-face-id-and-touch-id-to-the-web-with-safari-14/>) and building in physical identifier comparables (<https://techxplore.com/news/2020-07-apple-passport-ids-iphone.htm>) that can be stored in the device secure element and be leveraged by the federated auth tech using WebauthN.

I see this as the next step in evolution for a passwordless world and full replacement (eventually) of the CAC/PIV.
