A nationwide effort among federal and state governments, industry, and non-profit organizations to promote safer online behaviors. As of September 2013:

- **35** government partners have joined the Campaign's **Cyber Awareness Coalition**
- **34** non-profit partners have joined the Campaign's **National Network**
- More than **33,000** individuals have opted in to become **Friends of the Campaign** and to receive information on cybersecurity awareness
