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# E.O. 13434

- **Executive Order 13434**, signed on May 17, 2007, states that “In order to enhance the national security of the United States, including preventing, protecting against, responding to, and recovering from natural and manmade disasters, such as acts of terrorism, it is the policy of the United States to promote the education, training, and experience of current and future professionals in national security positions in executive departments and agencies.”

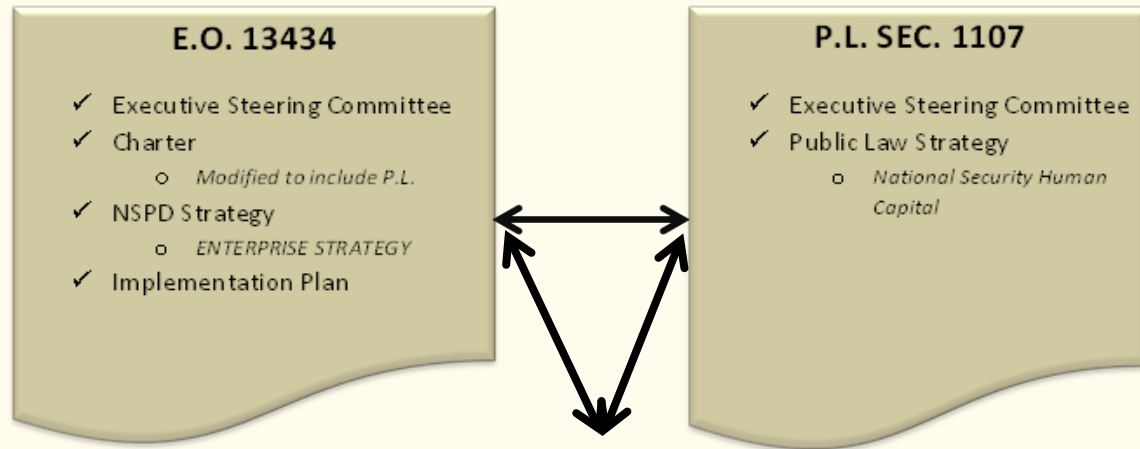
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# Public Law §1107

## **P.L. 112-239, §1107, INTERAGENCY PERSONNEL ROTATIONS**

§1107 was enacted in order to “increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the Government by fostering greater interagency experience among executive branch personnel on national security and homeland security matters involving more than 1 agency.” This integrated approach will improve the capability of the Federal executive branch to safeguard the security of the Nation while validating the National Security Professional Development program.

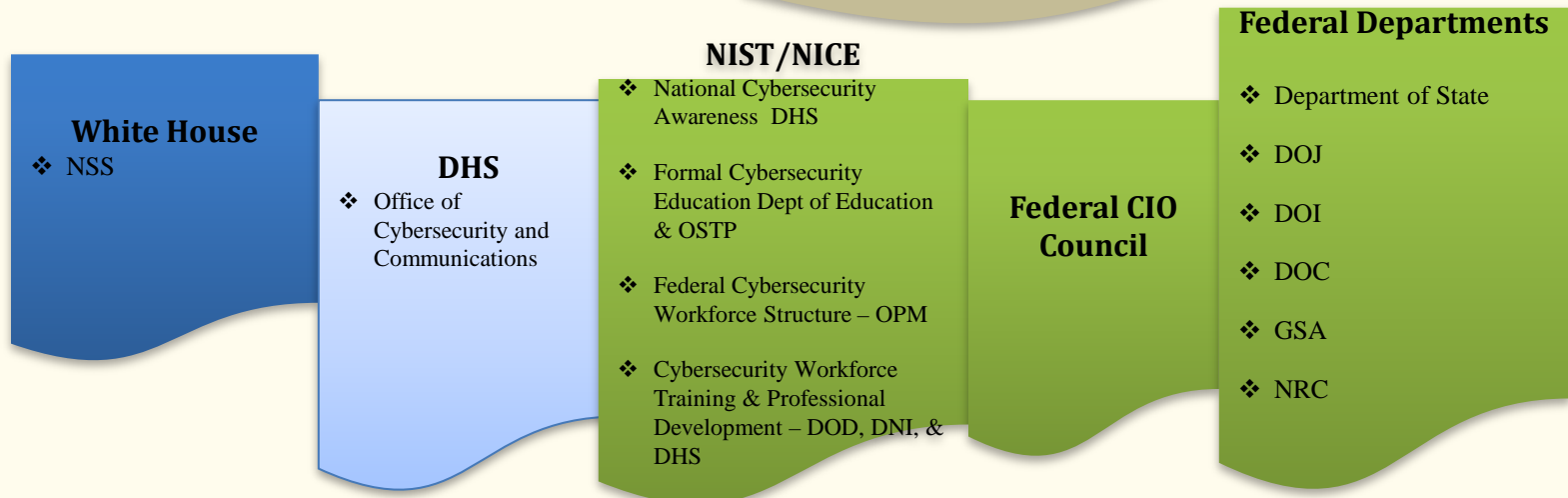
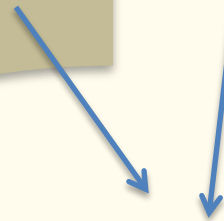

- Implementation of an integration and analysis function for critical infrastructure that includes operational and strategic analysis



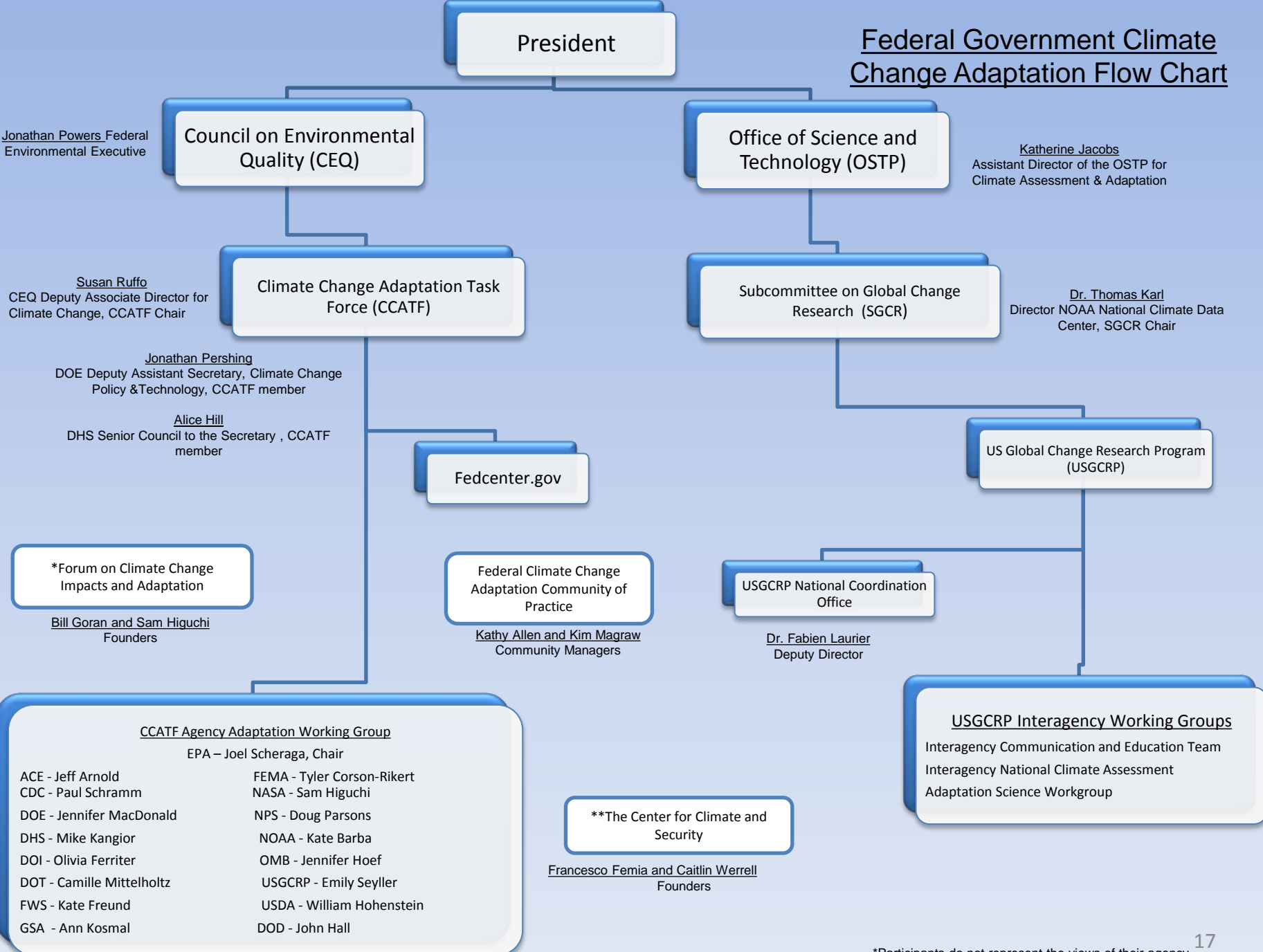

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# Proposed Legislation

Currently OMB is collecting input on a proposed Executive Order entitled “Preparing the United States for the Impacts of Climate Change.”

The proposed order establishes an interagency council and a task force of State, local, and tribal Leaders to address preparedness for the impacts of climate change, which include increased heat, more intense storms, wildfires, extreme precipitation, drought, and sea-level rise.

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# PUBLIC LAW: STABILIZATION AND RECONSTRUCTION (S&R)

- P.L. requires during each of the first 4 FYs after the FY of enactment; I/A rotation program be carried out in ... a COI for S&R
- S&R has a low probability of success
- Suggested that Security Sector Assistance (SSA), PPD-23 be substituted
- Initially, NSS, State, DoD, USAID, Justice and DHS supportive, but want law change
- Way ahead; Get Treasury and next level of NSS support. Discuss with HSGAC and GAO. Introduce language change for FY-14 NDAA
