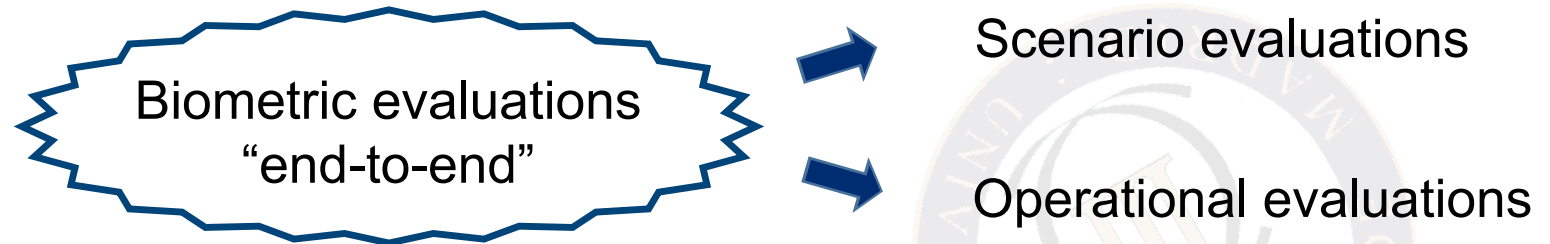


# Environmental Scenarios

- Defined considering the environmental parameter under study
  - This parameter shall be set to an specific value
  - The rest of them shall be kept inside the range defined in the standard scenario
- Three kinds of environmental scenarios
  - Operational range
  - Extreme conditions
  - Free conditions



# Biometric Evaluation



- Specific requirements for performing the environmental tests:
  - Environment: particular scenario to test
  - Users: special guides and training
  - Acclimatization
  - Data collection: matching scores and environmental data collected at the same moment
  - Performance metrics: they shall be calculated for different scenarios
