Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated in the unincorporated areas of Marshall County, as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Seventy-five percent (75%) for property tax relief. Twenty-five percent (25%) for bridge repair upkeep and replacement.
