Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Where can I include Letters of Support in my proposal?

A: Letters of support are not required. Please see Section IV.2.b of the NOFO. Applicants should carefully follow the instructions and recommendations regarding attachments and use the **Download Submitted Forms** and Application features on grants.gov

Q: Who is eligible to apply?

A. Applicants must be a U.S. based for-profit or not-for-profit institution or organization. An eligible applicant may work individually or may include proposed subawards to other organizations to carry out the activities described in the proposal.

Q: What is the application due date?

A. Full Applications must be received at grants.gov no later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time, Wednesday, March 17, 2021. Applications received after this deadline will not be reviewed or considered. Paper applications will not be accepted.

Q. What is the page limit for the technical proposal?

A. The technical proposal is limited to twenty-five (25) pages double spaced, noting the limit of two (2) pages for the Executive Summary. Resumes are not included in the page count of the Project Narrative. However, if resumes are included, resumes must be a maximum of two (2) pages each.
