NIST and the NDAA (P.L. 116-283)

- Specifies budget, expenditures and policies of the DOD for FY21.
- 7/21/20: passed the House by a vote of 295-195
- 11/16/20: passed the Senate by voice vote.
- 12/8/20: Conference report passed House 335-78, 1 present
- 12/11/20: Conference report passed Senate 84-13
- 12/23/20: VETOED by President Trump
- 12/28/20: House overrides veto 322-87 (2/3 vote required)
- 1/1/21: Senate overrides veto 81-13
- 1/1/21: Became P.L. 116-283

NIST and the NDAA (P.L. 116-283)

- Law contains many provisions related to Commerce/NIST programs and activities.
- No monies provided to carry out mandates
- Many provisions mandate consultation/coordination/collaboration
- Provisions apply across numerous NIST labs and programs:
