In section 4.1.5 Supply Chain Risk Management Category, subcategory SC-2 – we are wondering as part of Supply Chain, should PNT equipment users consider countries of origin of equipment?

Executive Order on Securing the United States Bulk-Power System, EO 13920 requests energy sector focus on a goal of limiting the acquisition or use of *“equipment designed, developed, manufactured, or supplied by” entities subject to the control of foreign adversaries*. While this is just one sector’s requirement, it may be good for others as well.
