Missouri allows Absentee and mail in voting but it must be received by 5pm on Election day and is a 2 week window prior to the date of election . To request absentee it must be done every election one month prior .

In order for those to vote with disabilities it should be automatic registration of absentee / mail in . should be mailed to the person with a disability from the election authority with more time to fill out and return and to allow it post marked by election day.

There were many ballots returned late by United States Postal Services.
