General Comment

Americans with disabilities are given limited and sometimes no access to voting. I am the Executive Director of a non-profit providing support to over 130 adults with disabilities. In order to vote, information has be packaged in an understandable way for those with language and processing issues. Secondly, the ability to vote is dependent on having a legitimate ID and voting card. Many of the people we support do not have access to "their" information. Many times it has been lost, never requested, or we are unable to access it. Using one's medicaid card should be an alternative to a State issued ID. Voting access is usually ADA accessible, but transportation and staffing are an issue. The ballot structure needs to be presented so that those that have language and processing issues can make an informed decision.
