**EXPLANATION:** The Nevada Revised Statutes were amended by the 1997 State Legislature to include a provision mandating the inclusion in the sample ballot of a list of those candidates and offices for which there is no opposition, NRS 293.565(4). Minor Party and Independent candidates are prohibited from being listed on a Primary Ballot, NRS 293.1715(1) and NRS 293.200(7). Unopposed candidates for General Improvement Districts seats are prohibited from appearing on any ballot, NRS 293.09523.
