**INSPECT THE

Look at the domain to verify that you're on an official website before you provide your credentials.



**USE
BOOKMARKS**

Use bookmarks to navigate to trusted sites.



**GUARD YOUR
CREDENTIALS**

Keep your usernames, passwords and security questions and answers private.
